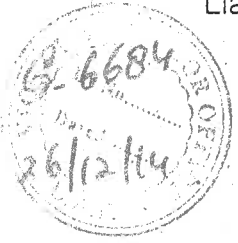

ANTI SMOKING / NARCOTICS FREE INSTITUTIONS POLICY

1. Create awareness against Smoking / Drugs / Narcotics through organizing Seminars, Talk Shows, Dramas, and Tableaus in Colleges.
2. Drug free week will be organized in colleges in collaboration with Anti-Narcotics Force Punjab and Drug Free City Lahore Project.
3. Banners & Posters will be displayed in Colleges during Drug Free Week.
4. Awareness Walks will be arranged in Colleges highlighting importance of Drugs / Narcotics free society.
5. The College Staff shall be prohibited from smoking according to the Govt. Policy and strict action will be taken against those breaching the instructions.
6. "Sheesha Smoking" will be completely banned in Educational Institutions.
7. A certificate will be produced by the heads of the institutions that all the necessary steps have been taken for providing Smoking / Narcotics free environment.
8. Awareness programmes will be organized for the prevention of Smoking as well as Narcotics in the Colleges. This activity shall be made a regular feature of annual activities.
9. Smoking / Narcotics free institutions will be awarded appreciation letters.
10. Print & Electronic Media will be utilized for dissemination of information against smoking & narcotics.
11. Teacher's Training Programmes will include Anti-Narcotics instructions as a part of Training syllabus.
12. Inclusion of Anti-Narcotics as a part of Zero Period syllabus at 1st Year and 3rd Year level.
